

## How to Run Data Reports in e2Fulton

This document is intended to be a high-level overview for how to pull demographic and performance measure data in e2Fulton.

There are two data reports discussed in this document.


- *HAB Performance Measures* shows your agency's performance measures. It allows you to filter for service categories, funding source, and/or provider, but does not let you filter within sub-populations. More performance measures are available in *HAB Performance Measures* than in *e2Visual Analytics*.
- *E2Visual Analytics* can be used to pull:
  - Demographic information about populations served.
  - Information on subpopulations by using filters and breakdowns.
  - Drill-down information on four Performance Measures:
    - Viral Load Suppression
    - Prescribed Antiretroviral Therapy (ART)
    - Annual Retention in Care
    - Gap in Medical Visits
    - Medical Visit Frequency


## Step 2: Select appropriate Date Range

This is the date range that a client received a service. It is recommended to run most data for a one-year period. See [Appendix B](#) for recommended date ranges.


The report will list the measurement periods at the top of the report.






The report will show you the *Measurement Period* (one year for most measures). The data will display with the numerator, denominator, and percentage. You can click on the blue question mark icon  for the data definition for each measure. Measures with special notices on how to run them such as Medical Visit Frequency will have an exclamation point icon . See [Appendix A](#) for available measures.





## Step 3: Under Display Options → Select Section

Under Display Options, select a Section. This will determine *which data* is displayed.

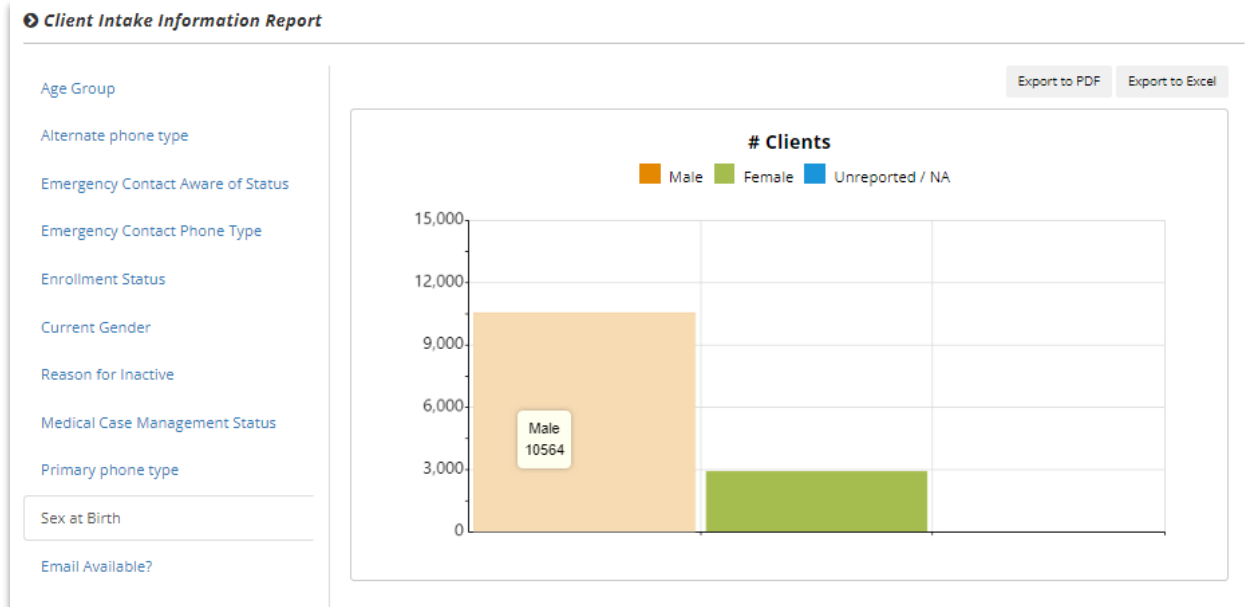

Each section will display data in multiple tabs. Click on the desired tab to get data on the variable of interest. See [Appendix C](#) for more information on the Sections and Tabs.



**Step 4 (optional): If desired, select or breakdown the data by population of interest**

You can get at select populations by either using *Custom Filters* or *Breakdowns* or a combination of the two. It is also possible to run the data without using any filters or breakdowns.

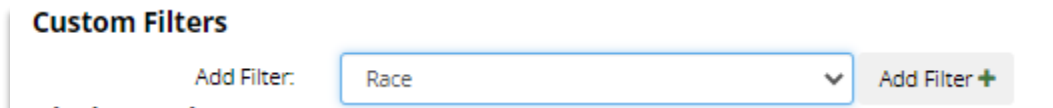

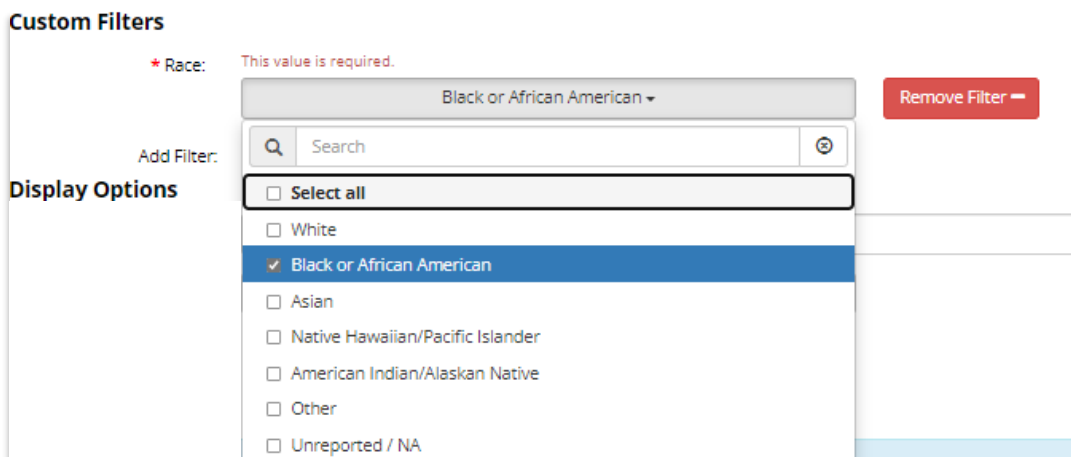
### Step 4a. Using Custom Filters

*Custom Filters* are useful for looking at a specific population of interest. You can add multiple custom filters to get a select population (i.e., African American MSM).

To add a *Custom Filters*, click on the *Add Filter* drop menu and select the desired filter.



Click the grey *Add Filter* button. Click on the dropdown menu and select **only the population you are interested in.**



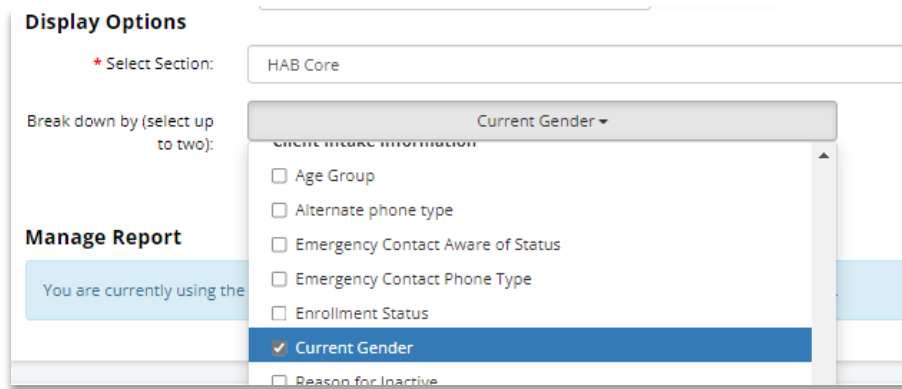
The system will display this information as a single table, but only the population selected will display (in the example above, only African American individuals).

### Step 4b. Using Breakdowns

Breakdowns are useful for getting stratified data. This will break up a measure by the breakdown that you select.

To add a *Breakdown*, click on the drop-down menu and select the desired breakdown. The system allows you to select up to two breakdowns.



The system will show this as stratified data or data broken down by what was selected (in this case, current gender).

## Step 5: Run the report

Once you have completed Steps 1-4, select the “Run Report” button.



Navigate through the *Section* tabs to get at the data you need. The data will display in graph and table form. You can export this to PDF or excel.




## Using the information for QA/QM

Another useful feature of e2Visual Analytics is the ability to export a list of clients that you can use for Quality Assurance or to obtain information on select populations. Selecting the blue hyperlinked number in the table will take you to a *Client Drilldown*.

The *Client Drilldown* gives you patient level information with their e2ID, first name, and last name. It allows you to export to excel or go directly into a patient's chart using the blue hyperlinks.

## Appendix D: Custom Filters & Breakdowns in e2Visual Analytics

The following reflect the most common filters and breakdowns, although more are available for use than listed here.

### *Client Demographics*

- **Ethnicity:** Hispanic or Latino/a, Non-Hispanic or Latino/a, Decline to Identify, Unreported/NA
- **Race:** White, Black or African American, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Other, More than one selected, Unreported/NA
- **County (filters only):** Filters for client's county of residence

### *HIV Status*

- **HIV Risk Factors:** Male to Male Sexual Contact (MSM), Injection Drug Use (IDU), Hemophilia/coagulation disorder, Heterosexual contact, Receipts of blood transfusion, blood components or tissue, Perinatal transmission, Risk factor not reported or not identified, More than one selected
- **HIV/AIDS Status:** HIV negative, HIV positive, not AIDS, HIV positive, AIDS Status unknown, CDC defined AIDS, HIV indeterminate (infant less than 2 years only), Unreported/NA

### *Client Intake Information*

- **Age Group:** Less than 13, 13-19, 20-44, 45 and older, Unknown, Unreported/NA
  - **Note:** For the most accurate information, use [Age Range](#)
- **Current Gender:** Male, Female, Transgender Male to Female, Transgender Female to Male, Transgender Other, Unknown, Unreported/NA
- **Sex at Birth:** Male, Female, Unreported/NA
- **Intake date (filters only):** Filters for a client's intake date. You can use this filter to identify newly enrolled clients.

### *Housing and Insurance*


- **Housing Status:** Unstable, Temporary, Stable, Unreported
- **Medical Insurance:** Private-Employer, Private-Individual, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, or other public plan, VA, Tricare, and other military health care, Indian Health Service, Indian Health Service (IHS), Other Plan, No Insurance/Uninsured, Unreported/NA

### *Income (listed under Housing and Insurance for filters)*

- **Income Group:** Equal to or below Federal Poverty Line (FPL), 101-200% of FPL, 201-300% of FPL, 301-400% of FPL, 401-500% of FPL, Greater than 500% of FPL, Unreported/NA

### Medical (Filters Only)

- **Viral Load:** This allows you to run filter data for Viral Load at last test regardless of date filter. Use the drop-down menus to select the range. You can also select to include clients without Viral Loads or with undetectable Viral Loads.




To get the most accurate age information, select *Age Range* under *Custom Filters*. Select *Add Filter*.
